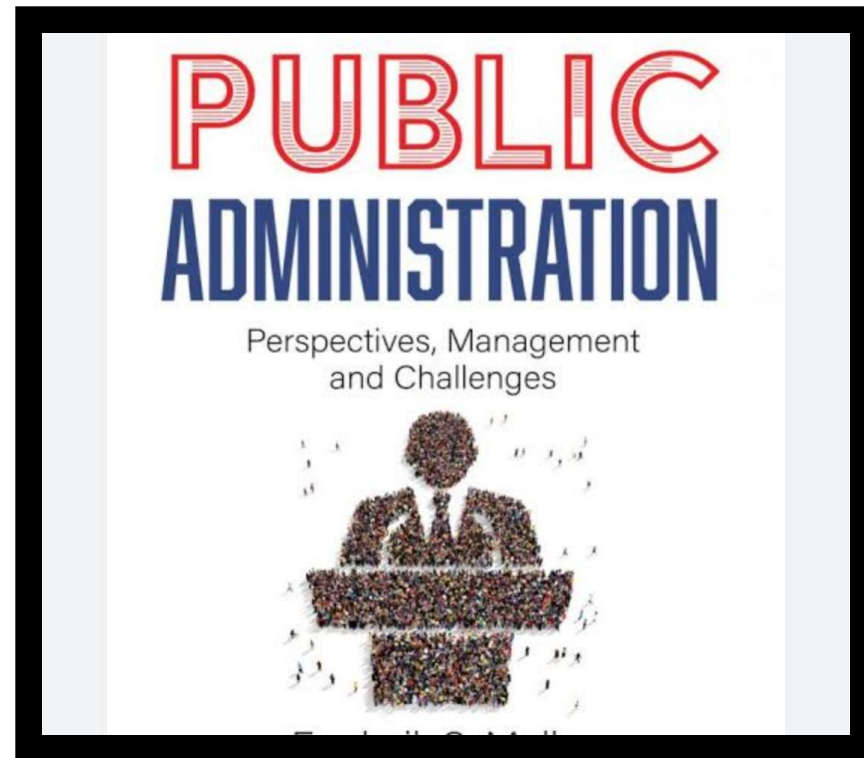

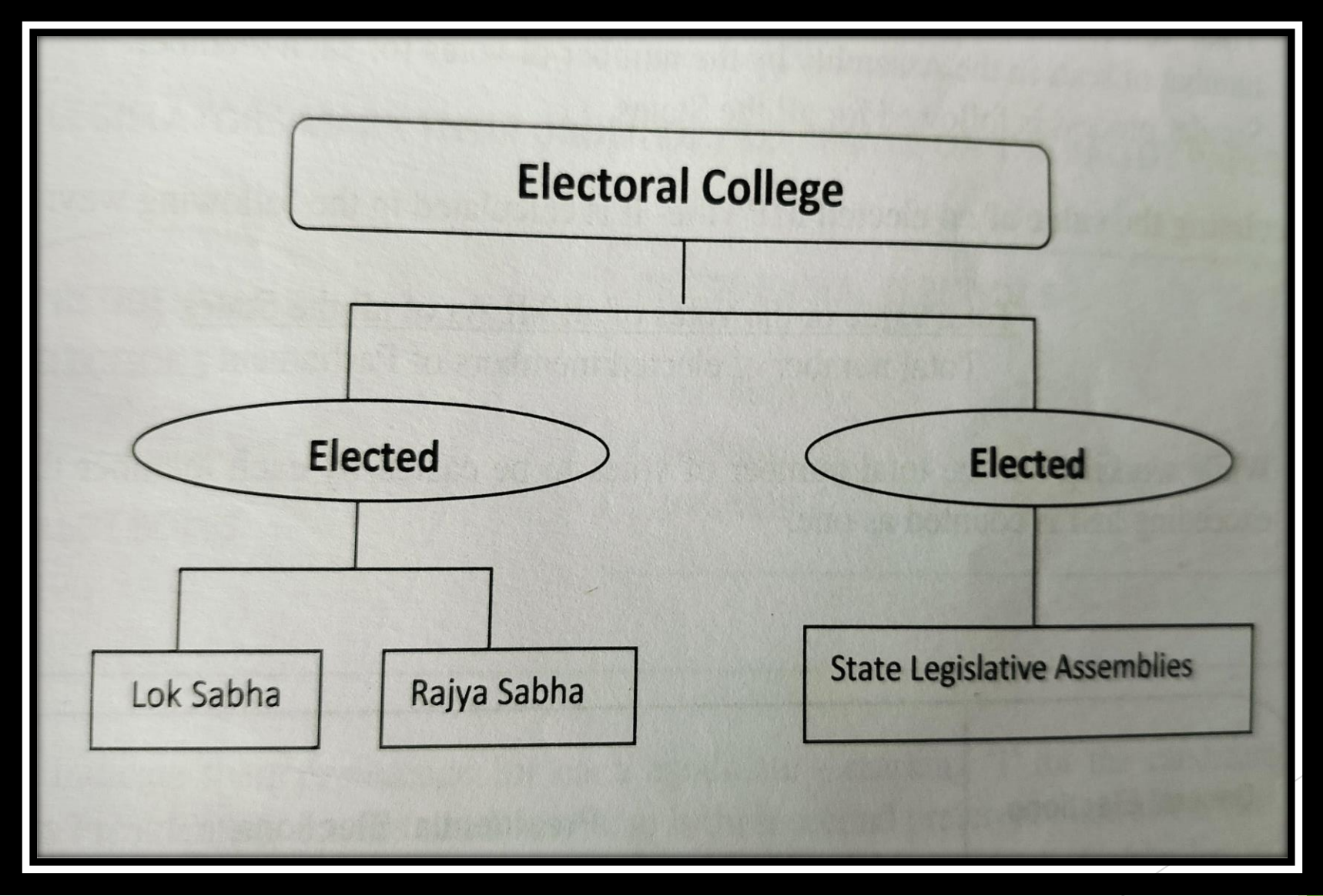
Smt. Droupadi Murmu was sworn in as the 15th President of India on 25 July, 2022. Previously, she was the Governor of Jharkhand from 2015 to 2021. She has devoted her life to empowering the downtrodden as well as the marginalised sections of society and deepening the democratic values.

## ELIGIBILITY

- ▶ **He should be a citizen of India**
- ▶ **He should have completed 35 years of age.**
- ▶ **He should be qualified for election as a member of lok sabha.**
- ▶ **He should not hold any office of profit under the union government or State government or any local or other authority.**
- ▶ **He should not be member of either parliament or state legislature.**

## **ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT**

- ▶ **The President of India is indirectly elected in other word it is not directly elected by the citizen of the country.**
- ▶ **According to article 54 the president shall be elected by the members of an electoral college consisting of**
- ▶ **Elected members of both the houses of the parliament**
- ▶ **Elected members of the legislative assembly of state.**



# NOMINATION

- ▶ **The first step towards the election of the office of the President is the nomination of a candidate which take place in the following manner**
  - 1. The candidate must be subscribed by at least 50 electors as proposers and 50 electors as seconders.**
  - 2. The candidate have to make a security deposit of rupees 15000 to reserve Bank of India.**
