#### LECTURE BY DR. GITANJALI

The lecture was delivered by Dr. Gitanjali that was main fo healthy HB levels amongsthe females. She told the audience about the healthy lifestyle changes and dietary changes to be followed in order to prevent anaemia. She explained the main causes of anaemia such as the deficiences in Folates, Vitamins B12, and Vitamin A that must be taken care of by taking healthy food and supplements. She recommended the audience to take pulses, beans, brownrice, nuts and seeds, dried fruits including apricot to maintain healthy lifestyle.
