Note: Only those students who attend the rehearsal will be awarded degrees on the day of the convocation.

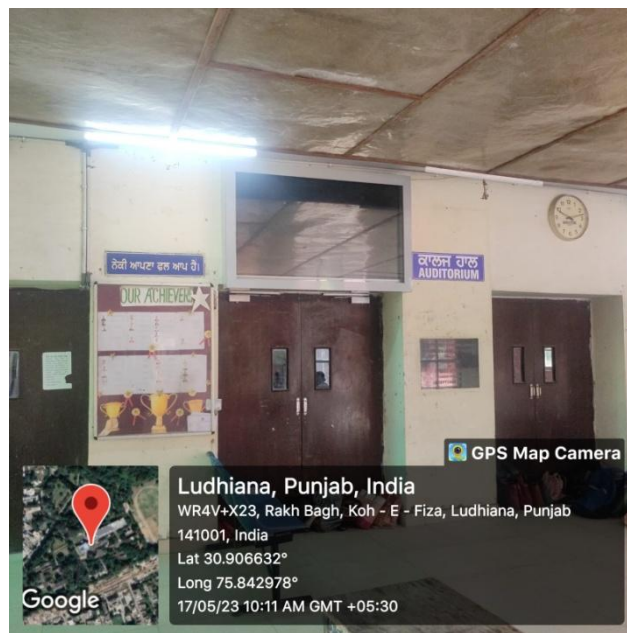
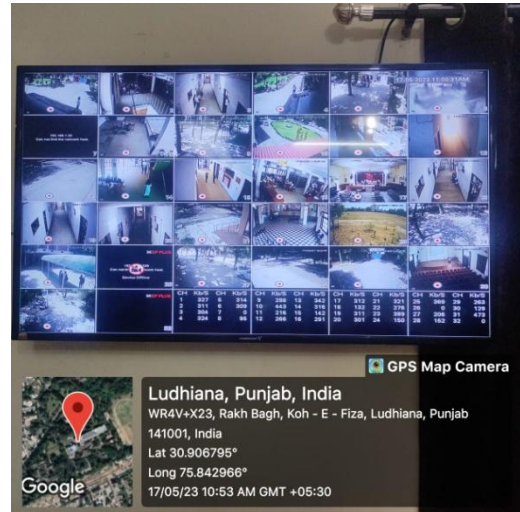

The NSS unit of GCG Ludhiana celebrated Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav on the occasion of 73rd republic day in virtual mode.

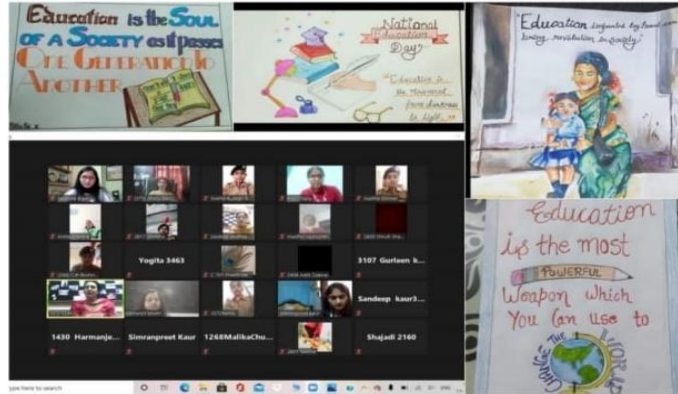
Activities:

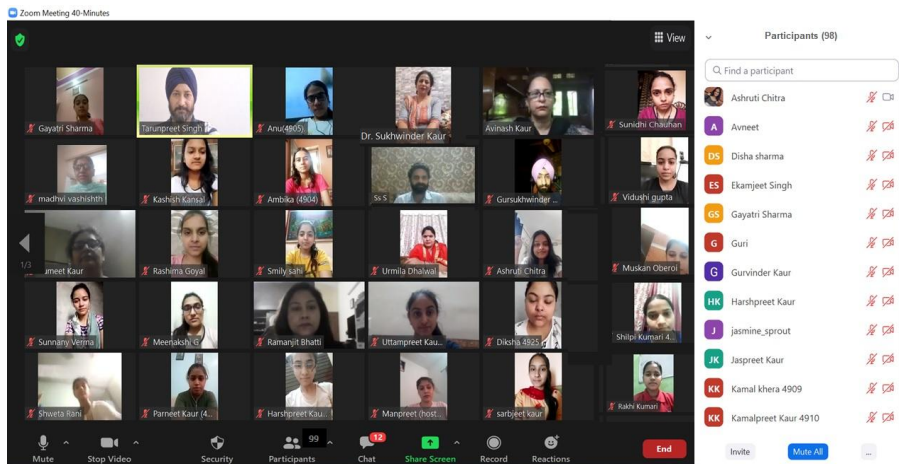

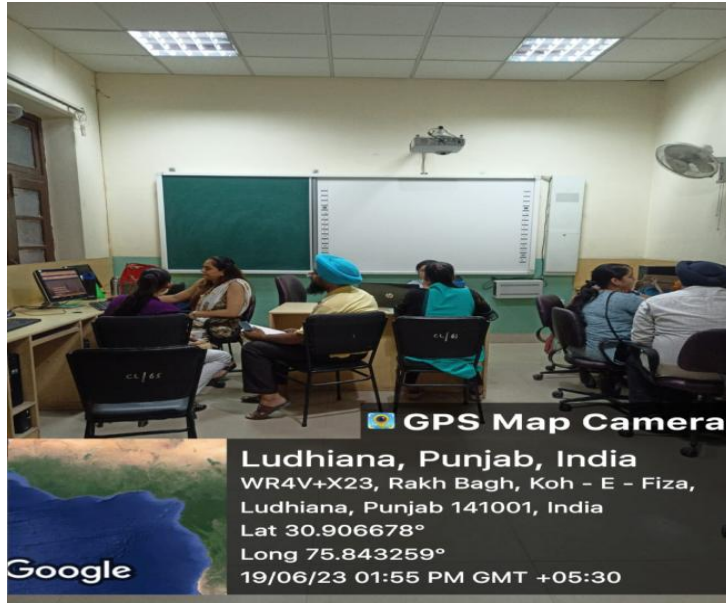
